

## FIBA Champions League - Men

As the ULEB created its own European club competition in summer 2000 they simply used the name EuroLeague as FIBA had forgotten to trademark the name. FIBA Europe had to find a new name for its own top tier level competition creating the **SuproLeague**. This SuproLeague was folded after one season due to the agreement between FIBA Europe and ULEB harmonizing the several club competitions in the seasons 2001/02 and 2005/06 - 2015/16.

As a result of these negotiations in 2002/03 FIBA Europe started the **FIBA Europe Champions Cup** as a third-tier level club competition (ranking behind EuroLeague and EuroCup both ruled by ULEB). In the seasons 2003/04 and 2004/05 the competition runs under the name **FIBA Europe League**, followed by the **FIBA EuroCup** in 2005/06 - 2007/08. For the longest period the competition was called **FIBA EuroChallenge** (2008/09 - 2014/15).

The agreement between FIBA Europe and ULEB ended after 2015/16 season. FIBA Europe tried to get back the leading position in European club basketball, creating the **Champions League**. But ULEB still runs its own competitions with the best European basketball clubs. So, the Champions League is the third-tier competition further on.

**Format:** 2000/01 regular season in a group stage, Best of Three last 16 round and quarter final, knock-out Final Four

2002/03 a regional qualifying round played in three conferences was succeeded by the Pan-European phase in groups, home & away quarter finals, knock-out Final Four

2003/04 - 2004/05 qualifying round in groups, best of three 1/8 and quarter finals, knock-out Final Four

2005/06 - 2006/07 round I and round II in groups, best of three quarterfinals, knock-out Final Four

2007/08 first two rounds on home & away basis, group stage, best of three quarterfinals, knock-out Final Four

2008/09 two qualifying rounds on home & away basis, regular season and Top 16 in groups, best of three quarterfinals, knock-out Final Four

2009/10 regular season and Top 16 in groups, best of three quarterfinals, knock-out Final Four

2010/11 - 2012/13 one qualifying round on home & away basis, regular season and Last 16 in groups, best of three quarterfinals, knock-out Final Four

2013/14 - 2014/15 regular season and Last 16 in groups, best of three quarterfinals, knock-out Final Four

2016/17 two qualifying rounds on home & away basis, regular season, Play-offs qualifiers, round of 16 and quarter finals on home & away basis, knock-out Final Four

2017/18 - 2018/19 three qualifying rounds on home & away basis, regular season, Play-offs round of 16 and quarter finals on home & away basis, knock-out Final Four

2019/20 three qualifying rounds on home & away basis, regular season, Play-offs round of 16 and knock-out Final Eight (instead of quarter finals on home & away basis, knock-out Final Four scheduled for May 01 + 03 due to the COVID-19 pandemic)

2020/21 qualifying round as mini tournaments, regular season and Play-off round of 16 in a group stage, knock-out Final Eight.
