

Basketball at the Women's World Games of FSFI (historical)

On 1921 Oct 31, the French Alice Milliat (president of FSFI 1921-1936) founded with representatives from five countries the **Fédération Sportive Féminine Internationale (FSFI)** as result of refusal to include women track and field events in the Olympic program by both IOC and IAAF. In response to the refusal, the FSFI organized its own Women's World Games from 1922 - 1934. In the third and fourth edition, also basketball tournaments took place.
