

Maccabiah Games before World War II

Parallel to the Maccabi Congress 1929 in Ostrava TCH, sports competitions took place (1st European Maccabi Games). At the Congress, Yosef Yekutieli (Eretz Yisrael's representative) suggested that regular sports competitions for all Maccabi members should be held in Mandatory Palestine. These Maccabiah Games were first held in 1932.
